DARWIN FESTIVAL TO CREATE SPECTACULAR LIVE ENTERTAINMENT VENUE

The Darwin Festival will truly be a sight and experience to be remembered this year, with the transformation of the George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens into a lively

entertainment hub in a tropical, outdoor setting for 18 days and nights.

The entertainment hub will feature an impressive open-air sound shell, called the **Star Shell**, stages, entertainment areas, food and beverage outlets, and information and ticket booths.

The **Star Shell**, previously used at the Sydney Olympics, Womadelaide and Adelaide's Symphony Under the Stars, will be located in the Botanic Gardens and will be a centre of activity with music, theatre, dance, comedy and cabaret performances from 6.30pm to 9.30pm every night of the Festival, followed by live music and entertainment at the **Festival Club** from 9.30pm until late.



The Darwin Festival venue at the Botanic Gardens will be open over the 18 days and nights of the Festival, from August 12 – 29. Many of the events will be located at the Festival venue, however there will still be events at other venues throughout Darwin.

performances are captivating and his talent unmistakable, which goes some way to explaining the huge level of


support that he attracts where ever he tours. Xavier is currently on a sell-out tour of the USA. **Tickets to Xavier Rudd are on sale now.**
